

Mental Hygiene Article 83
out of state guardianship appointments

Items required:

1) certified copy of:

A) the order appointing guardian from other state.

B) letters of office

C) a bond. If it is a protective order under section 83.37 of the Mental Hygiene Law, a bond may be required (only if the order from original state calls for it).

2) an affirmation or affidavit providing:

a) under what section of law they are seeking to register.

83.35 is for the guardian of the person

83.37 is for a protective order

b) reason it needs to be filed in this county. Must be a specific reason. Cannot just file it arbitrarily.

c) there is **no** petition for the appointment of a guardianship of the person, or a petition for a protective order pending in this state, whichever applies. (dependent on section of law they are moving under; i.e 83.35, or 83.37)

3) copy of letter of intent to file

~~An index number must be purchased (\$210.00).~~

Credit cards, Postal money orders, or attorney's check accepted.

Can pay in cash if you come to the office in person.
